

## Triad Austin Healey Car Club Minutes

The Triad Austin Healey Car Club met on Monday, April 03, 2006 at the Sagebrush Steakhouse in Kernersville, NC. Due to torrential rains and a tornado warning, only 9 members were in attendance.

The Drivers' meeting is at Noon. Arrive early enough to enjoy a late breakfast or an early lunch at one of several restaurants along that street. Last year there were just over 100 cars running so come out and represent the Healey!

It was reported that the "First Saturday of the Month Breakfast" on April 1<sup>st</sup> was very successful, with 19 people in attendance.
